FIREARM AMNESTY (2010/01/11 – 2010/04/11):

“AWULETHE UMSHINI WAKHO – SURRENDER YOUR FIREARM”

The residents and business community of the SANDTON Policing area are advised to take note of the following:

- An amnesty period (2010/01/11 to 2010/04/11) has been announced by the Minister of Police and published in the Government Gazette No.111, dated 25th November 2009.
- Individuals who inherited firearms, sold firearms, store firearms for safekeeping; Private Security companies, firearm dealers, gunsmiths and manufacturers with obsolete and redundant firearms and ammunition;
- The general public including Youth groups, Religious Forums, NGO, Sporting Associations are requested to surrender their unwanted, surplus and unlicensed firearms to the Sandton Police, SAP 13 store during this AMNESTY PERIOD.

Report illegal firearms to the South African Police Service.

Be responsible – the correct safekeeping of your firearm can save lives.
