PARKMORE FAMILY FUN DAY

Parkmore families are invited by the Parkmore Community Association to our annual Family Fun Day.

All the fun will take place around the football field below the clubhouse, including the team games, children's food and drink, and special activities. Here there are plenty of shady trees, but feel free to bring umbrellas and chairs (a limited number will be provided by the PCA and SSC).

We have arranged lots of fun activities, including a famous local Magician, Tractor-trailer kids rides, a Treasure Hunt for the young at heart, a Water slide for the children, Tug-a-War for the tough, a football knockout tournament for the energetic and competitive, and then we need lots of enthusiastic cheering supporters.
